## SPEAKER BIOS

Greg Crane Greg enjoyed a career as a Texas police officer until 2002, serving at various times as a patrol officer, field training officer, crime scene investigator, SWAT officer, and SWAT team leader. He also served for eight years in Kosovo as part of US Army Force Protection Team. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice from Midwestern State University, and a Master's Degree in Forensic Science from George Washington University. He now travels around the country conducting Active Shooter Defense training programs and seminars. After evaluating and assessing the Columbine tragedy with fellow SWAT team veteran, Allen Hill, Greg co-founded the A.L.i.C.E. program and Response Options, a Critical Incident Training Company.

Ric Borom Ric was the Director of Education Services for notMYkid. He has also been High School Principal at Pinnacle Education, a Police Officer in Gilbert, Arizona, a SWAT Team member, and the Team Leader of the Hostage Negotiations section. Ric also ran a Residential Treatment Center in Scottsdale, Arizona. While he was a School Resource Officer serving at two high schools, each with a population of over 3,000 students, he was also an instructor in the following areas: Mobile Field Force (Riot Control), Hostage Negotiations, SRO training, Crisis Deescalation, Establishing and Maintaining Boundaries, Dealing with the Mentally Ill, Active Shooter Training and Lock Down/Lock Out Training.

David Papargiris David Papargiris is the director of the Massachusetts Attorney General's Computer Forensics Lab. Prior to accepting the position David Papargiris was a police officer for over 22 years with the Norwood Police Department and was assigned to the bureau of Criminal Investigation for 10 years. Since 1998 David Papargiris has been investigating computer crimes and conducting computer forensic analysis on computers and digital media. He was a Deputy of the United States Marshall with the United States Secret Service, New England Electronic Crimes Task Force. David is an Adjunct Instructor at the Bristol Community College where he teaches courses on Introduction to computer forensics, Advanced computer forensics and File system forensics.

### DIRECTIONS

#### From East

Take Interstate 93 South to I-95 North towards Dedham. Stay North to Exit 15B (Route 1 South). Travel on Route 1 South for 4.5 miles and the hotel will be on the right hand side

#### From North

Take Interstate 95 south to Exit 16B (Route 1 South). Go through 2 traffic lights and the hotel will be on the right hand side.

#### From West
